Midway City Sanitary District customers have 3 bins (black, blue, and green). The blue recycle bin is for all of your papers, plastics, and other recyclable material. The green bin is for yard and food waste. Paper towels can also be used to soak up grease and put into the green bin. There are only about 5 items that belong in your black bin. Those are cat litter, bathroom waste, cigarette butts, disposable diapers, and medication. Sorting properly is important to the environment and helps keep our trash collection costs low.
